On May 1, 2007, the State of California, Bureau of Bureau for Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education (BPPVE), granted Aristotle University College of Law, a division of Aristotle University, the FULL FIVE (5) YEAR APPROVAL as a California private postsecondary degree-granting institution with full degree-granting authority in all subject areas requested by Aristotle University.

Subsequently, effective November 2007, Aristotle University received degree granting authority and registered with the Committee of Bar Examiners, State Bar of California, for its three (3) law schools: Aristotle University College of Law – Carlsbad (onsite legal education); Aristotle University College of Law – Temecula (onsite legal education); and the Aristotle University Institute for Law and Jurisprudence (distance legal education). The degree-granting authority granted by the Committee of Bar Examiners and the law schools' registration with the Committee of Bar Examiners qualify our law students to take the California Bar Examination and obtain admission to the practice of law in California based on the law schools' registration as an unaccredited law school with the Committee of Bar Examiners.

J.D. Degree Program – AUCL (Carlsbad)

With respect to the professional law degree of Juris Doctor (J.D.) Degree the Committee of Bar Examiners, The State Bar of California, requires the following disclosure:

The method of instruction at this law school for the Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree program is principally in physical classroom facilities.

Students enrolled in the J.D. degree program at this law school who successfully complete the first year of law study must pass the First-Year Law Student's Examination required by Business and Professions Code § 6060(h) and Rule VIII of the *Rules Regulating Admission to Practice Law in California* as part of the requirements to qualify to take the California Bar Examination. A student who passes the First-Year Law Students' Examination within three (3) administrations of the examination after first becoming eligible to take it will receive credit for all legal studies completed to the time the examination is passed. A student who does not pass the examination within three (3) administrations of the examination after first becoming eligible to take it must be promptly disqualified from the law school's J.D. degree program. If the dismissed student subsequently passes the examination, the student is eligible for re-enrollment in this law school's J.D. degree program, but will receive credit for only one year of legal study.

Study at, or graduation from, this law school may not qualify a student to take the bar examination or to satisfy the requirements for admission to practice in jurisdictions other than California. A student intending to seek admission to practice law in a jurisdiction other than California should contact the admitting authority in that jurisdiction for information regarding the legal education requirements in that jurisdiction for admission to the practice of law.

Professional Law Degrees OTHER THAN the J.D. Degree – AUCL (Carlsbad)

With respect to professional law degree programs OTHER THAN for the J.D. degree (e.g., LL.M., etc.), the Committee of Bar Examiners, The State Bar of California, requires the following disclosure:

The method of instruction at this law school for professional law degree programs other than for the Juris Doctor degree is principally in physical classroom facilities.

Completion of a professional law degree program at this law school other than for the Juris Doctor degree does not qualify a student to take the California Bar Examination or to satisfy the requirements for admission to practice law in California. It may not qualify a student to take the bar examination or to satisfy the requirements for admission to the practice of law in any other jurisdiction. A student intending to seek admission to practice law should contact the admitting authority in the jurisdictions where the student intends to seek to qualify to sit for the bar examination or for admission to practice for information regarding the legal education requirements in that jurisdiction for admission to the practice of law.
